

The Haledon Board of Health (Passaic County) seeks a part-time public health nurse:

Under direction, teaches, counsels, conducts epidemiological investigations, and provides public health nursing services in homes, clinics, and schools to individuals and families in the community; uses knowledge from nursing, social and public health sciences to promote and protect the health of populations through the performance of core public health functions and the delivery of essential public health services; organize an annual flu clinic and periodic blood pressure clinics; attend Board meetings; coordinate with school nurses as needed; coordinate with the board's Health Officer, Board Secretary and Office of Emergency Management (OEM); keep updated inventory for the Point of Distribution Plan; follow up with reported animal bites and adverse reactions to contaminated food; does related work as required.

Examples of work include: respond to health questions during home visits, in clinics or schools, or by the board of health; visit homes and gather initial background information; develop a healthcare plan; implement actions to curtail communicable diseases by instructing high-risk individuals in proper control measures; investigate suspected disease outbreaks; measure patients' temperature, blood pressure, pulse, height and weight; maintain records; report monthly to the Board; keep healthcare information secure and confidential.

Applicants must have one year of experience in a public health field or nursing experience, possess a current and valid registration as a professional nurse in New Jersey and a valid driver's license. Working knowledge or fluency in Arabic and/or Spanish is highly sought.
