

HALEDON BUSINESSES REQUESTING TO SERVE FOOD OR BEVERAGE IN OUTDOOR AREAS

Certain criteria have been established by the State of New Jersey and the County of Passaic regarding use of outdoor space for serving food and beverage. The Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control and the Commissioner of the Department of Health have also established permits and protocol requirements.

- Businesses interested in providing outdoor dining should complete the Borough of Haledon Outdoor Café application which is filed with the Haledon Construction Department Office.
- Liquor License owners that have a retail consumption license must apply online through POSSE to apply for a COVID-19 Expansion of Premises Permit.
- Businesses using a County right-of-way to provide outdoor dining on the sidewalk or a closed section of the street will require the Borough of Haledon to request a “Streets Open for Business” permit with Passaic County. This permit will require business owners to first complete an Outdoor Café application with the Haledon Construction Department Office.

Although Governor Murphy has issued Executive Order No. 150, before any business begins serving food and beverage outside; they must apply for and receive the proper permit.
